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| 1. | MACABEO, VALDEMORADA
Spain
This fresh dry Macabeo displays well-defined fruity aromas of peach and apple, with floral notes. Fresh and rounded in the mouth, with a long, smooth aftertaste of flowers and fruit. | £5.30 | £7.05 | £13.30 | £19.95 |
| 2. | SAUVIGNON BLANC, ETNIA, MANCURA,
Chile
Crisp and refreshing, with aromas of grapefruit and lemon peel lending a fresh balance to the tropical fruit character. Vibrant and well-rounded. | £5.80 | £7.90 | £15.20 | £22.00 |
| 3. | PINOT GRIGIO, TERRE DEL NOCE
Mezzacorona, Vigneti delle Dolomiti IGT, Italy
Elegant, dry Pinot Grigio with apple and banana fruit aromas, floral lift in the mouth and a clean, crisp finish. | £6.10 | £8.10 | £15.80 | £23.50 |
| 4. | TORRONTES, FINCA LA COLONIA, BODEGA NORTON
Mendoza, Argentina
A sophisticated, dry, elegant rendition of this aromatic grape variety: combining minerality with white peach and floral notes such as rose and jasmine. | £6.65 | £8.80 | £17.20 | £25.50 |
| 5. | CHARDONNAY, DOMAINE COSTE
VdP des Côtes de Thongue, France
Clean, precise, mineral Chardonnay - no oak here, just delicate apple fruit and a crisp refreshing finish. | £7.00 | £9.25 | £18.20 | £27.00 |
| 6. | SAUVIGNON BLANC, MAHI
Marlborough, New Zealand
Musky aromas and flavors of lemon-lime, pepper and herbs, plus a subtle suggestion of ripe peach. Plush and broad but with harmonious spicy, grapefruit notes giving the wine lift. Fresh but fully ripe and nicely tactile, even plush, and long on the aftertaste. | £8.50 | £11.75 | £23.50 | £35.00 |
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7. **PICPOUL DE PINET, BEAUVIGNAC 2018** £27.00
Languedoc Roussillon, France
Elegant aromas of citrus, pear and white flowers and a crisp, mineral palate ideally suited to seafood.
 8. **CHABLIS 1ER CRU, 'VAU DE VEY', JEAN-MARC BROCARD, 2015** £54.00
Burgundy, France
This is fleshy, wrapping a lush texture around apple, lemon cake and stone flavours. Intense and long. Wine Spectator 90 points. The Vau de Vey shows delicate citrus and floral aromas, as well as some smoky mineral touches. Medium-bodied and savoury on the palate, this is complex characterful Chablis!
 9. **VIIGNIER, 'REVELATION', BADET-CLEMENT, 2018** £30.00
Vin de Pays d'Oc, France
Bursting with Viognier character: apricots, peaches and preserved citrus fruit. The palate is both smooth and fresh, with hints of spice.
 10. **GRÜNER VELTLINER, ZERO-G 2018** £32.00
Wagram, Austria
Light in body yet intensely flavoured, this Grüner Veltliner offers the typical white pepper and crisp greenfruit aromas of the variety, allied to a creamy texture particular to the Wagram region. The balance is really satisfying, the wine refreshing from start to finish!
 11. **RULLY BLANC, DOMAINE JACQUESON 2016** £45.00
Burgundy, France
Pinpoint ripeness here, with apricot and apple aromas, followed by Rully's typically firm, medium-bodied palate. Fresh and satisfying, and a fine ambassador for this well-known village.
 12. **MEURSAULT, 'VIEILLES VIGNES', VINCENT GIRARDIN 2015** £70.00
Burgundy, France
A classic, taut Meursault offering aromas of roasted almonds, white flowers and mineral notes. The fresh, pure structure conceals impressive weight and concentration.
 13. **GEWÜRZTRAMINER, ONE TO ONE, ESTATE RESERVE, MORANDE 2018** £30.00
Casablanca, Chile
Aromas of rose and orange blossom lead to flavours of lychee, mandarin and gingery spice, all coming together beautifully on the long, clean finish. A wonderful expression of this exotic varietal.
 14. **CHARDONNAY, 'LANDSBOROUGH VINEYARD, DOMAINE TOURNON 2016** £40.00
Victoria, Australia
Chapoutier, possibly the most iconic wine maker from the Rhone Valley, has decided to bring his 'magic' to Victoria in Australia. Fresh and crisp, with an abundance of ripe stone fruit flavours. There is plenty of fruit weight on the palate and the finish has keen acidity, a hint of savoury, and good minerality.
 15. **SANCERRE, LA CROIX DU ROY LUCIEN CROCHET 2017** £45.00
Loire Valley, France
Notes of citrus fruits, blossom, peach and pear on the nose. Nice pure entry, fruity and crisp on the palate. Good length and classic mineral flavours.
 16. **ALBARIÑO, SERRA DA ESTRELA 2018** £30.00
Galicia, Spain
From the coolest part of Rias Baixas, this wine bursts with juicy Albarino character: pear, citrus fruit, musky perfume and hints of mineral and spice. Clean and intense.
 17. **GAVI DI GAVI 'LA MEIRANA' BROGLIA 2018** £37.00
Piedmont, Italy
Adam and Val visited the winery recently and loved it! Great texture and precision, with distinctive greengage and almond notes on the palate. Fresh and dry, this is particularly characterful Gavi, with a lovely finish! Just ask Adam.

18. **TEMPRANILLO, VALDEMOREDA** £5.30 £7.05 £13.30 £19.95
Spain
Lovely red fruit flavours cherry and some black berry fruit flavours. loaded with spice. and a good finish.
19. **CABERNET SAUVIGNON/MERLOT, ETNIA MANCURA** £5.80 £7.90 £15.20 £22.00
Chile
This wine boasts a bright ruby-reed colour. Pronounced blackberry flavours mingle with touches of leather and chocolate. In the mouth the wine is soft and fruity with perfectly balanced fine tannins.
20. **SHIRAZ, FOUNDERS BLOCK, KATNOOK ESTATE** £7.75 £10.85 £21.55 £32.00
Coonawarra, Australia
Lovely Shiraz aromas of blueberries, blackberries and cinnamon lead to luscious yet a lively palate that balances typical coonawarra fruit elegance and density. with a floral-spicy lift.
21. **MALBEC, PORTEÑO, NORTON** £7.00 £9.25 £18.20 £27.00
Mendoza, Argentina
This luscious Malbec has aromas of violets, strawberries and black cherries. leading to a smooth, full-bodied palate with a hint of peppery spice.
22. **CÔTES-DU-RHÔNE, MAZETS DE SAINT VICTOR 2017** £7.20 £10.20 £20.50 £30.00
Rhône Valley, France
With Syrah to the fore, this is full of berry fruit, violet, liquorice and spices. It has a generous, rounded palate and a long, elegant finish.
23. **PINOT NOIR, LES PARCS GUY ALLION** £8.50 £11.75 £23.50 £35.00
Loire, France
Strawberry-fruited and creamy-textured, this is a joyously ripe, juicy Pinot with a good deal of cool-climate finesse.
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| 24. TINTO, QUINTA DA CASSA 2017
Douro, Portugal
Touriga Nacional, Tempranillo, and Touriga Franca make this something rather different and interesting. Aromas of red berries and spices, full bodied, with a really good finish. | £28.00 |
| 25. PINOTAGE, CLOOF 2016
Stellenbosch, South Africa
The bold, concentrated flavours of this wine are directly attributable to the yield of mature bush vines growing under extreme conditions. Richly textured with notes of smoke, blackberry, plum with some spiciness and elegant oaky notes. | £33.00 |
| 26. RIOJA RESERVA, PROMESA, VINA BUJANDA 2012
Rioja, Spain
A classic style of Rioja with strawberries, blackberry and rhubarb fruit flavours beautifully integrated with 'toasty' oak flavours, taking on a hint of vanilla and cocoa, and showing a smoothness, and finesse that comes from over 20 months aging in oak barrels! | £39.00 |
| 27. BROLO DI CAMPOFIORIN ROSSO DEL VERONESE IGT, MASI 2014
Veneto, Italy
An impressive, complex nose of berry fruits and a touch of vanilla. Rich, baked fruit flavours on the palate with hints of cocoa. Impressive structure and length, with a soft and velvety finish. | £38.00

Bordeaux, France
An expressive nose of roasted plums, dried herbs and fresh earthy notes leads to a medium-full, currant-infused palate of both breadth and focus. | £38.00 |
| 29. BROUILLY, CHATEAU DE LA PERRIÈRE 2017
Burgundy, France
This juicy Brouilly shows a fine spectrum of fruit, especially raspberries, Morello cherries and blackcurrants. There is some typical Brouilly power on the palate, but a good deal of finesse as well. | £35.00 |
| 30. CHATEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE, DOMAINE DE BEAURENARD 2016
Rhône Valley, France
An immensely fruity nose, with spicy and balsamic notes, then great complexity on the palate: power, finesse, and an incredibly long, mineral-fresh finish! | £72.00 |
| 31. AMARONE, COSTASERA DELLA VALPOLICELLA CLASSICO, MASI 2012
Veneto, Italy
Aromas of preserved cherries and dried plums together with hints of cinnamon. Good weight from the alcohol and structured on the palate, with aromas of cherries and vanilla. | £75.00 |
| 32. CHATEAU BATAILLEY, SEME GRAND CRU CLASSE, PAUILLAC 2010/12
Bordeaux, France
Dating back to 1400's this is one of the older estates! A Cabernet Sauvignon based wine, showing ripe tannins, succulent cassis dark chocolate and tobacco. Juicy and crisp a traditional Pauillac! | £90.00 |

50. **TAWNY PORT FERREIRA** £4.00 £27.00
Portugal

A fresh and delicate aroma, reminiscent of spices and dry fruit, acquired during
oak ageing. In the mouth this is an elegant wine that shows a fine balance
between structure and sweetness, providing it with an attractive, long finish.

51. **LATE BOTTLED VINTAGE FERREIRA 2011** £4.50 £32.00
Portugal

The intense aroma is dominated by very ripe black fruit (blackcurrant, blackberry
and prune), along with chocolate, cocoa, floral aromas and a slight hint of spices
(pepper). In the mouth it is a full-bodied wine with great balance between
sweetness and ripeness.

52. **QUINTA DO PORTO 10 YEAR OLD TAWNY FERREIRA** £5.50 £41.00
Portugal

The nose is characterised by an excellent balance between the floral and ripe
fruit aromas of the grapes themselves and the spicy, dry fruit aromas of long
ageing in barrel. The palate shows the classic, fresh Ferreira style, achieving
a fine balance and harmony.



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
